

DELL GROVE TOWN BOARD MONTHLY MINUTES

August 2, 2011

The Dell Grove Board of Supervisors met August 2, 2011, 8 p.m., at the Dell Grove Lutheran Church. Present were Supervisors Dan O'Flanagan, Randy Davis, Treas. Frank Grundmeier, and Clerk Janet Foss. Supervisor Nick Harris was absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The previous minutes were read. Randy made a motion, seconded by Dan, the minutes be approved. Carried. The Treas. Report was read with an ending balance of \$62,390.52 in checking and \$8,019.658 in the Bldg Fund. Randy made a motion, seconded by Dan, to accept the report. Carried.

Dan received a call from Soil and Water that they want to do some stabilizing on the lakeshore by Wahlberg's barn where people drive onto and off the lake. Soil and Water would pay 80%, the Township 20%, the apx. Cost being \$3000. Dan suggested they contact DNR for cooperation.

Central Applicators will be spraying in Kanabec County soon. Discussed spraying a couple roads to see the results. The apx. Cost is \$250 per mile, depending on bush density. Discussed meeting with a company rep. for them to see some of our roads in question. Dan will contact their rep.

A party contacted Dan on what the procedure would be to buy property, then build a private airport. Dan will talk with the zoning officer---would a conditional use permit be needed?

Graveling to be done yet: Southfork, Olson Rd south near the turn-around, Watrin Road from Miller Rd to Yellow Birch Rd, and Groningen Loop. Some road washing has happened by Miller Rd.

No fire calls have been paid. Randy made a motion, seconded by Dan, that since no payment was received by the deadline of August 1, 2011, the Lind fire call will be put against the property taxes. Carried.

Discussed the overflow culvert where the river leaves the lake—it is unnecessary and we hope to dissuade the DNR from requiring it be replaced.

Randy made a motion, seconded by Dan, to pay the bills. Carried.

Randy made a motion, seconded by Dan, to adjourn. Adjourned 9:10 p.m.
