

SNOW REMOVAL POLICY FOR DELL GROVE TOWNSHIP

The Township does not assure a completely bare road. Users of the road system are reminded to exercise caution and drive with care.

1. Dispatching of Snow Plow

Only the Town Board has the authority to dispatch the plow. It will not usually dispatch the snow plow until after the snowfall has stopped. During extended periods of snowfall, exceptions may be made. The snow plow will not be sent out in situations that may be hazardous due to restricted visibility.

2. Personal Properties

- A. Mail boxes and fences damaged during snow removal will be evaluated on a case by case basis. Only those mail boxes that were properly located and installed and which were damaged by actual contact with the plow will be repaired at Township expense.
- B. Township residents are reminded that it is unlawful to plow snow from driveways onto or across public roads. Piles of snow left on or near the road can freeze into a solid mass creating a hazardous situation for vehicles and the snow plow. Accidents and damages caused by snow piles placed in the roadway may result in liability to the property owner.
- C. Township residents are reminded to remove parked vehicles from Township roads to assist the snow removal.
- D. The Township shall not be held liable for any damage due to obstructions in driveways or yards when plowing driveways.
